GOVERNMENT FEES (TRADE MARKS AND SERVICE MARKS) AMENDMENT
REGULATIONS 2010

BR 14 / 2010

The Minister of Finance, in exercise of the power conferred by section 2 of the Government Fees Act 1965, makes the following Regulations:

Citation

1 These Regulations may be cited as the Government Fees (Trade Marks and Service Marks) Amendment Regulations 2010.

Revokes and replaces Schedule

2 The Schedule to the Government Fees (Trade Marks and Service Marks) Regulations 1993 is revoked and replaced by the contents of the Schedule to these Regulations.

Commencement and transitional

3 (1) Subject to paragraph (2), these Regulations come into operation on 1 April 2010.

(2) Nothing in these Regulations affects the validity of a fee that is paid before the coming into operation of these Regulations.
