## HOSPITAL INSURANCE (STANDARD PREMIUM) REGULATIONS 2005

### ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

1 Short title 4 Revocation of BR 20/2004

2 Standard premium 5 Commencement

3 Persons over the age of 65

The Minister of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred on her by section 40(1)(b) of the Hospital Insurance Act 1970, makes the following Regulations:

#### Short title

1 These Regulations may be cited as the Hospital Insurance (Standard Premium) Regulations 2005.

## Standard premium

2 Subject to regulation 3, the standard premium payable in respect of standard hospital benefit shall be \$136.24¢ a month (or \$31.44¢ a week where paid weekly) of which \$16.75¢ a month (or \$3.86¢ a week) shall be paid into the Mutual Re-Insurance Fund.

### Persons over the age of 65

3 The standard premium payable in respect of standard hospital benefit for persons over the age of sixty-five years who do not qualify for

subsidised hospital treatment under section 2(1)(b) of the Act shall be \$494.71¢ a month (or \$114.16¢ a week) of which \$16.75¢ a month (or \$3.86¢ a week) shall be paid into the Mutual Re-Insurance Fund.

## Revocation of BR 20/2004

4 The Hospital Insurance (Standard Premium) Regulations 2004 are revoked.

#### Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on 1 April 2005.
