1 This Notice may be cited as the Marine Board (Control Over Maritime Traffic) (No. 4) Notice 2007.

Escape to Bermuda Triathlon Swim Race

2 The Escape to Bermuda Triathlon swimming race will take place between a position 1 mile due east of Dockyard at Latitude 32° 19.32' N, Longitude 064° 49' W to King's Stairs under the Dockyard Clocktower on Sunday 21 October 2007 between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 8:30 a.m.

Closure of a certain section of Hamilton Harbour
