TRAFFIC OFFENCES PROCEDURE ORDER 2010

BR 42 / 2010

The Minister responsible for Transport, in exercise of the power conferred by section 23(1) of the Traffic Offences Procedure Act 1974, makes the following Order:

Citation

1 This Order may be cited as the Traffic Offences Procedure Order 2010.

Amends Schedule 1

2 Schedule 1 to the Traffic Offences Procedure Act 1974 is amended—

- (a) under the heading “Auxiliary Bicycles (Construction, Equipment and Use) Regulations 1955” by inserting the following next after the entry in respect of Paragraph 11—

“Driving or causing or allowing another person to drive an auxiliary bicycle while using a hand-held mobile telephone, a hand-held device or a hand-held electronic entertainment device contrary to Auxiliary Bicycles (Construction, Equipment and Use) Regulations 1955 Paragraph 12”;

- (b) under the heading “Motor Car (Construction, Equipment and Use) Regulations 1952 by inserting the following next after the entry in respect of Paragraph 42—

“Instructional vehicle being equipped with seating other than for the driver and person sitting next to the driver contrary to Motor Car (Construction, Equipment and Use) Regulations 1952 Paragraph 43(b)

Failing to have painted on the side of an instructional vehicle letters showing that it is an instructional vehicle contrary to Motor Car (Construction, Equipment and Use) Regulations 1952 Paragraph 43(c)

Driving or causing or allowing another person to drive a motor car while using a hand-held mobile telephone, a hand-held device or a hand-held electronic entertainment device contrary to Motor Car (Construction, Equipment and Use) Regulations 1952 Paragraph 44

Driving or causing or allowing another person to drive a motor car equipped with a television, computer or other device with a display screen visible to the driver contrary to Motor Car (Construction, Equipment and Use) Regulations 1952 Paragraph 45".
