

**AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF  
INDIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE  
HUNGARIAN PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC  
RELATING TO THE COOPERATION  
IN THE FIELD OF INFORMATION**  
**Budapest, 27 September 1978**

The Information Office of the Council of Ministers of the Hungarian People's Republic and the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting of the Republic of India,

GUIDED BY the desire to further strengthen the friendly relations between the two nations,

TO PROMOTE greater understanding between their peoples,

TO FURTHER widen their knowledge of developments in their respective countries, and to these ends,

AIMING TO develop cooperation in the field of information,

HAVE AGREED as follows :

*Article I*

The Contracting Parties will undertake to supply each other with information on developments in their respective countries and progress achieved by their respective peoples in order that public opinion in both countries could be informed through their respective means of mass communications.

*Article II*

The Contracting Parties will promote the mutual exchange of their experiences in the field of information.

*Article III*

The Contracting Parties will encourage cooperation between their Radio and Television organisations, journalist associations, as well as their news agencies.

*Article IV*

The Contracting Parties will promote the exchange of radio and television programmes, press materials and newsreel documentaries.

*Article V*

The Contracting Parties will conclude a plan of work to ensure the implementation of the present Agreement.

*Article VI*

The present Agreement shall enter into force on the date of exchange of notes.

*Article VII*

This Agreement shall remain in force for a period of five years and shall automatically be renewed for a further five-year period unless notice of termination is given by either of the Contracting Parties six months before the expiry of the Agreement.

This Agreement was signed in Budapest on 27 September, 1978 in two original copies in each of Hungarian, Hindi and English languages, all being of equal authenticity.
